Guests/ Day Sailing Guidance Can I Bring / Invite Non-Members to HISC?

We have recently received a lot of questions about the rules for Day-Sailing and, nonmembers coming to the Club.

Who can come to HISC

To come to Hayling Island SC you need to be one of the following types of people:

- A Club Member
- A Guest of a Club Member
- A participant in an Event

Your Guests

Members may bring an individual to visit the Club as a guest up to 6 times in a calendar year (HISC Bye-law 2.3).

Guests must be signed into the Visitor's Book by the hosting member and collect a visitor's wristband from Reception upon entering Club premises.

The Member must be on site with the Guest and is responsible for the guest whilst at HISC.

Day Sailing

Day Sailing is required where Guests are bringing their own "craft" (*i.e boat/board*) and, are sailing from HISC. In order for Guests to Day Sail you will need to do the following (HISC Bye-law 4.18):

- **Request Permission**: Please inform the Office of your guests visit to HISC and request permission for them to bring their own boat/board with them. Permission may be refused at particularly busy times of year.
- **Pay Day Sailing:** Any guest going on the water in their own "craft" must pay Day Sailing Fees. This includes those participating in Board sports or paddle sports. As of July 2024 Day, sailing rates are currently as below:
 - £14 for a Single-Handed craft
 - £23 for a double handed craft
 - £36 for triple handed craft.
 - Exceptions: Members guests sailing in a member's vessel already registered with the Club do not need to pay Day Sailing.

- Day Sailing exclude Harbour Dues which your Guest will need to pay <u>Harbour Dues & Charges - Chichester Harbour Conservancy</u>
- **Sign In:** Guests must be signed into the Visitor's Book by the hosting member and collect a visitor's wristband from Reception upon entering Club premises.
- **Overnight Storage**: Craft may not be left overnight unless consecutive days have been paid for in advance.
- **Be Insured against 3rd Party risks:** up to a minimum of 2 million pounds (HISC Bye-Law 4.23)
- **Club Racing:** Participation in Club racing requires prior agreement from the Office and is generally restricted.

We kindly ask all members, and their guests follow these rules. Thank you for your cooperation in maintaining a safe and enjoyable environment for everyone.
