The Senior Marine Technician will be responsible to the Marine Manager for the maintenance of club assets, this includes, but is not limited to, equipment used for RYA Training, Racing, Cruising and Youth in all its forms. You will supervise the completion of maintenance work and marine personnel under the direction of the Marine Manager. The role will be a practical, can do, problem-solving role that will be flexible around ensuring equipment is functional when is it needed.

Main Responsibilities

- Support for the Marine Manager in supervising the Marine Team to ensure work is to a high standard and within club policies.
- Taking a leader's role for maintaining all marine equipment required for the operation of the racing, cruising and training within the club programme. Maintaining HISC standards as a centre of excellence.
- Work with contractors and complete purchases as approved by Marine Manager.
- To maintain the moorings in line with the clubs' policy for maintenance and renewal.
- To assist in the delivery of the winter layup under the direction of the Marine Manager.
- Help to ensure Marine COSHH is in line with club policy and compliant with regulations.
- Monitor and maintain the inventory of all the sailing club boats- safety kits, flags, horns and course boards. Ensure all boats are fuelled and clean.
- Assist with the running of the tender and other boat driving duties.

- Complete maintenance checks, fill in maintenance logs in line with the club policy.
- To drive club plant machinery to complete launch and recovery operations.
- To maintain clean and safe working areas, inside the boat shed and the yard.
- To rig hire boats as required.
- To complete inductions, training, and development of Marine Staff in safe operating practises and Health and Safety procedures.
- Assist with Boat Park / Sinbin processes and maintenance.
- Be a key holder for the Marine Department.
- To produce winter maintenance schedules and oversee the winter refit of all marine equipment.
- Keep and maintain accurate & comprehensive records of all maintenance.
- Dispose of waste / marine equipment under the direction of management.
